FLOWER FOR SCHOOL'S MEMORIAL TO QUEEN ELIZABETH.

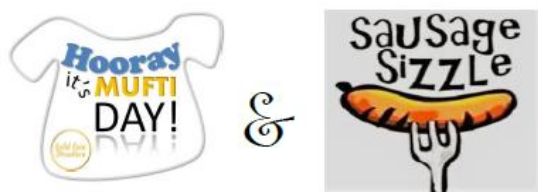
Tomorrow we are holding a memorial for Queen Elizabeth.

SAUSAGE SIZZLE AND MUFTI DAY – Friday 30th September (next week) For the first time in a long time, we are able to combine a sausage sizzle and mufti day on the last day of term. These have traditionally been regular events that have helped the FAB collect money to help them achieve our fundraising goals.

On the 30th September, we would like children who come to school in non-uniform clothes to bring a gold coin and hand it in to the their on arrival at school. This is then collected and deposited into the FAB bank account.

If you would like your child to have a sausage, this money is also handed to the child's teacher who will record it and send it to the office as well. The child will need to able to tell the teacher whether or not they would like to have a vegetarian, halal or 'mixed meat' which is pork and beef.

NZ NEEDS MORE TEACHERS! - From the Ministry of Education

On Wednesday 14 September the Government announced a multi-million dollar teacher supply funding package that they hope will deliver more teachers to New Zealand schools.

Attracting domestic teachers into the profession - Career changer scholarships

To encourage people to change career and become a teacher, the MOE offers two different types of career changer scholarships. Both pay course fees plus \$30k per year of study and are open from **15 September to 13 October**. These scholarships are very popular and we know career changers go on to enjoy fulfilling teaching careers.

- The number of Te Huawhiti career changer scholarships available for all sectors and subjects is increasing by 100 additional places to 185 places.
- In addition, 115 Te Waka Whakarei career changer scholarships are available for Māori-medium and te reo Māori teachers.

Teacher Education Refresh programme

As well as supporting schools to recruit teachers, the MOE is focused on attracting people into the teaching profession. To incentivise people to return to teaching roles, they will continue to fully fund the Teacher Education Refresh programme to be fees-free until **June 2023**. 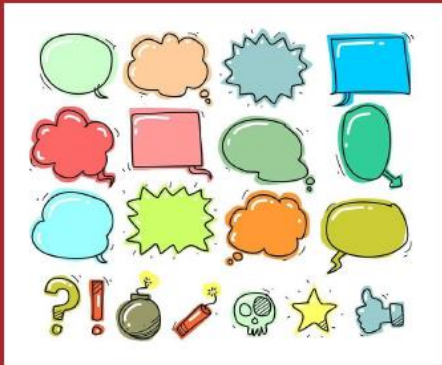

This programme allows teachers who have been out of the profession for five years or more to return to the field. This includes:

- Extending the Teach First NZ contract for the employment-based trainee teacher programme that will deliver 75 new teachers each year
- Launching next month a 'Become a Teacher' recruitment campaign, targeted at graduates and school leavers. The campaign has been developed in consultation with sector peak bodies and has been tested with audience focus groups.
