DEMOLITION OF ROOMS 19, 20, 21 22 AND 23

During the last holiday break, the ground subsidence behind these classrooms forced us to empty them out and relocate the classes of children elsewhere in the school. Since then, we have been emptying the rooms of anything that will be of use elsewhere in the school in the future and shutting down all of the services to the rooms such as water, power and electricity. We are now able to demolish these classes.

On the weekend, workers will be at the school to gut the inside of Rooms 19-23. Then from next Thursday onwards, the area will be closed so that the rooms can all be removed. We have met with Ministry of Education staff to ensure that this process can be completed safely.

We advise everyone to make sure that the children stay well away from this area during the removal process. More updates will be provided as we move through this process.

Knowledge-a-thon

WINTER SICKNESS

Increased levels of winter illnesses at the start of term are a common trend and when coupled with COVID-19, these can put significant pressure on schools and communities. The Ministry of Health modelling in July shows that numbers of severe respiratory illness cases, including both COVID-19 and flu, are well down. Your efforts will have certainly contributed to this outcome. That said, we had over 70 children away sick on Tuesday and this is evidence that we are not out of the woods yet! Please keep children at home for 48 hours after they have either been vomiting or had diarrhea. Thank you for continuing to keep the children at home if they are unwell.
