
You might want to discuss what we do at school with your child and could expand this to talking about what you might do in an emergency at your house if you think it is appropriate for their age

Good news: 75% of our students are reaching this goal!





We also want to help children come to school on time. Last term, **42%** of students were late at least once which is disruptive to the learning of everyone.

Please help your child come to school by 8:30am. This gives them time to get ready for their day.

Monday 2nd of June is a public holiday and school will be closed to recognise King's Birthday Weekend.




Food Orders

Jammies for June


Join Dame Valerie Adam's Jammie Army!
