Rules around adult to child ratios may be found here:

Swimming with children aged 5 years and under

- An adult or caregiver aged 17 years or older **MUST** be in the water and within arms reach of all children aged 5 years and under, at all times.
- One adult can supervise up to two children 5 years and under (must be in the water).
- One adult can supervise one child aged 5 years and under and up to three children aged between 6 and 10 years (must be in the water).



Swimming with children aged between 6 and 10 years old

- An adult or caregiver aged 17 years or older **MUST** be actively supervising. You must be watching the children and be ready to help them, and be near your children so you can hear them and they can hear you.
- One adult can supervise up to four children aged between 6 and 10 years.
- One adult can supervise up to three children aged between 6 and 10 years and one child aged 5 years and under (must be in the water).
- We do not consider you to be actively supervising if you are using a mobile phone.

If you aren't able to meet the minimum adult to child supervision ratio you will be denied entry to the facility.
